Project Overview in Brief

The project **“Partnerships for quality and relevance in ICT vocational education in Moldova”** aims at assuring the quality and relevance of ICT vocational education for local, regional and national economy in Moldova, through the support in launching and ensuring the qualitative functioning of the Centre of Excellence for the VET ICT education, in view of advancing the harmonization of ICT education in Moldova with labour market demand. In addition, it aims at supporting the initial activity and functioning of the National Agency for Quality Assurance in Professional Education as an independent, functional and professional body.

The project is pursuing the following:

Impact: The career choices of young Moldovans are based on labour market needs and result in increased employment and enhanced labour productivity in the national economy.

This objective is reflected in the following project outcome: Inclusive in-school and out-of-school career guidance (CG) services available to young persons for their social and economic integration.

Project Overview in Brief

The “**FinPractice**” project aims at establishing a center for practical training of professionals in the Moldovan financial system. The training center is part of the existing Center of Excellence for Finance, established by the Moldovan Ministry of Education.

The target group consists of 15 apprentices trainees (VET teachers, adult education institute trainers, university lecturers and suitable business candidates), 15 trainee mentors (employees from the partner companies), 180 financial sector employees who receive capacity building activities through pilot training programs, and 70 jobseekers who have the conditions for higher qualification or basic qualification and are qualified (higher) by the pilot training.

The curriculum and training methodologies are developed in close collaboration with GRAWE, National Bank of Moldova, the National Commission for Financial Markets.

Project Overview in Brief

The project **“Increasing the competitiveness of the agri-food sector through integration to domestic and global value chains, in particular in the soya sector”** is aiming at improving the competitiveness of the agri-food sector through integration into domestic and global value chains, in particular in the soya sector.

The three-year-project is aiming at building a competitive, modern and sustainable Moldovan agri-food value chains with a focus on the following four components:

- Enhancing capacities for innovation and education in agriculture in Moldova;
- Increasing access to market and advancing the demand for certified and organic agri-food products on national and foreign markets;
- Use of standards and certification to raise the performance of value chains;
- Promoting an enabling environment for ensuring quality standards in the agri-food sector (including organic agriculture and products) and alignment of Moldova’s legal framework and policy documents to EU quality standard.
